POLICY DIRECTIVE

PURPOSE:

To provide policy and procedure requiring a written organizational chart that groups similar functions, services, and activities in administrative subunits throughout the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Superintendents; Directors of Correctional Industries, Parole Services, and Training and Staff Development; and Youth Reporting Center (YRC) Directors are responsible for maintaining Organizational Charts to ensure compliance with this Policy Directive.

CANCELLATION:

Any previous written instruction on the subject.

APPLICABILITY:

All facilities and work units within the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation (DCR). This Policy is available for general distribution.

DEFINITIONS:

None.

POLICY:

I. The Commissioner of the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation (DCR) provides a written document describing the agency's organization which is distributed throughout the agency. The organization chart delineates the structure of authority, responsibility, and

- accountability within the agency. As an overview of the agency, the organizational chart is also available to other public and private agencies.
- II. All Facilities, Correctional Industries, Parole Services, Training and Staff Development, Youth Reporting Centers (YRCs), and any other work unit as required, shall have a current organizational chart depicting functional areas and lines of responsibility. Organizational charts shall be available to all staff in those respective areas and maintained in Personnel Policy Manuals.
- III. In order to provide a clear administrative picture, all organizational charts will be reviewed at least annually and updated as needed.
