SUBJECT: <u>REGISTRATION OF</u> <u>OFFENDERS</u>

POLICY DIRECTIVE

PURPOSE:

To ensure that offenders who are convicted of qualifying offenses, for which registration is statutorily required, are notified of their registration requirements with the West Virginia State Police upon their release.

<u>REFERENCE:</u>

WV Code §§15-12-1 et al., and 15-13-1 et al.; and 81CSR14 and 81CSR16 Title 81 Procedural Rules of the West Virginia State Police.

RESPONSIBILITY:

No additional written instructions on this subject are required.

CANCELLATION:

Any previous written instruction on the subject including DOC Policy Directive 457.04, dated 01 February 2014; and RJA Policy 19002, dated 15 May 1997 and amended forms, dated 23 November 2004.

APPLICABILITY:

All facilities and work units within the Division of Corrections and Rehabilitation (DCR) that have custody of or supervise adult offenders. This Policy is available for general distribution and is to be made available for offender review upon the effective date.

DEFINITIONS:

None.

POLICY:

- I. As required by law, any person convicted of a qualifying offense, including those persons who are continuing under some post-conviction supervisory status, prior to his or her release from confinement, shall be informed of his or her duty to register and provide all information as required by state code.
 - A. Any person who has been convicted of an offense or an attempted offense under any of the state code provisions listed on Offenses Requiring Registration as a Sex Offender (Attachment #1) or under a statutory provision of another state, the United States Code or the Uniform Code of Military Justice which requires proof of the same essential elements, is required to register pursuant to the "Sex Offender Registration Act."
 - B. Any person who has been convicted of an offense under any of the state code provisions listed on Offenses Requiring Child Abuse and Neglect Registration (Attachment #2) or under a statutory provision of another state, the United States Code or the Uniform Code of Military Justice which requires proof of the same essential elements, is required to register pursuant to the "Child Abuse and Neglect Registration Act."
- II. Prior to the release of an offender required to register, the Reentry Coordinator will assist the offender in completing Notification of Sex Offender Responsibility and Incarceration Release (Attachment #3) or Notification of Child Abuser Responsibility and Incarceration Release (Attachment #4) as applicable. An offender who has previously completed these forms and/or registered as required who is re-incarcerated is required to update these forms and re-register at the State Police Detachment upon release from <u>any</u> incarceration.
 - A. Prior to the offender's release from incarceration, a copy of the completed form will be sent to the Registry by either emailing to <u>registry@wvsp.gov</u> or faxing to 304-746-2437.
 - B. A copy will be provided to the offender and uploaded to the appropriate file in the Offender Information System (OIS).
- III. A supervising Parole Officer, as part of the intake procedure, will ensure that any sexual offender or child abuse offender has completed the appropriate paperwork according to the requirements of this Policy.
 - A. Offenders supervised by Parole Services as an Interstate Compact case who have been convicted of an offense that requires proof of the same essential elements at the qualifying offenses listed on Attachments #1 or #2 will be required upon intake with Parole Services to complete Attachment #3 or Attachment #4 as appropriate.
 - B. The supervising Parole Officer will ensure a copy of the completed form is sent to the Registry by either email to registry@wvsp.gov or faxing to 304-746-2437 and a copy is provided to the offender and uploaded to the appropriate file in OIS.

OFFENSES REQUIRING REGISTRATION AS A SEX OFFENDER

Any person who has been convicted of an offense or an attempted offense under any of the following provisions or under a statutory provision of another state, the United States Code or the Uniform Code of Military Justice which requires proof of the same essential elements shall register as set forth in this Policy pursuant to the "Sex Offender Registration Act."

WV Code §61-8A-1 et seq.

Preparation, distribution or exhibition of obscene matter to minors

WV Code §61-8B-1 et seq.

(Also includes provisions of former §61-8B-6 of this code, relating to the offense of sexual assault of a spouse, which was repealed by an act of the Legislature during the 2000 legislative session.) Sexual assault, 1st, 2nd and 3rd degrees Sexual abuse, 1st, 2nd and 3rd degrees Imposition of sexual acts on persons incarcerated or under supervision

WV Code §61-8C-1 et seq.

Use of minors in filming sexually explicit conduct Distribution and exhibiting of material depicting minors engaging in sexually explicit conduct Prohibiting child erotica

Any person who has been convicted of a criminal offense where the sentencing judge made a written finding that the offense was sexually motivated shall also register. The term "sexually motivated" means that one of the purposes for which a person committed the crime was for any person's sexual gratification.

Any person who has been convicted of an offense under any of the following provisions or under a statutory provision of another state, the United States Code or the Uniform Code of Military Justice which requires proof of the same essential elements shall be required to register

If I have been court determined to be a Sexually Violent Predator I must re-register every ninety (90) days in the months of January,								
April, July and October with the detachment in the county I reside in or detachment that covers county of residency.								

If I am required to register as a resident of West Virginia and I am employed, carry on a vocation, attend school or training or am a visitor in another state, I must comply with the laws of that state and register in that state if required to do so.

If I become a resident of the State of West Virginia from another state, federal or military jurisdiction and I am required to register there, I shall be required to register in this state and I have ten (10) business days to register.

If I am a resident of another state and I am required to register in that state and I am employed, carry on a vocation, am a student, own or lease habitable real property that I visit regularly in this state or visit this state for more than fifteen (1 5) continuous days I must register and comply with the laws of the State of West Virginia.

Any person required to register must do so for a minimum period of ten (10) years after release from incarceration or from the date of conviction if given probation.

I must register for LIFE if one of the following applies:

- I was convicted of a sexually violent offense;
- I have one or more prior sexual convictions;
- -I was convicted of a qualifying offense and the victim was a minor;
- -I was convicted of a qualifying offense that involved multiple victims or multiple violations of the qualifying offense;
 - I have been determined to be a Sexually Violent Predator.

Failure to comply with these responsibilities as defined here as well as failure to comply with West Virginia Code §15-12, et seq. are criminal violations of West Virginia Law, for which I may be criminally prosecuted.

I have read the Notification of Sex Offender Responsibility and Incarceration Release and I attest that the information I provided and submitted to DOC/ Jail Authority is true and correct.

I understand that is not a registration but a notice of my intent to reside at the address provided and a notice of my responsibilities. I understand I must register with the WVSP within 3 business days after my release in the county of residence.

I have this date read and acknowledge that I must register as a **Child Abuser** with the West Virginia State Police Detachment in the county in which I reside, work, attend school or training. I must register within three (3) business days of my release from an institution. I understand that any person required to register must do so for a period of ten (10) years, except during periods of incarceration, after release from prison, jail or a mental health facility or from the date I was placed on probation, parole or supervised or conditional release.

I understand that I must report the local Detachment of the West Virginia State Police within ten (10) business days of any change in any of my registration information. This change of information must be reported in person. If this change in address or residence is to another county in West Virginia I understand that I must advise the State Police in person of the new address ten (10) business days prior to the move and I must register with the State Police in that county within ten (10) business days. If this change in address or residence is to another state I understand I must register in that state and comply with the laws of that state.

I understand that if I am a resident of another state and am required to register in that state and I am employed, carry on vacation, a student in this state or a visitor to this state for more than fifteen (15) continuous days that I must register and comply with the laws of this State. I understand that if I am required to register as a resident of West Virginia and I am employed, carry on vacation, attend school or training or am a visitor in another state, I must register with that state and comply with the laws of that state.

I understand that if I change residence to this state from another state, federal or military jurisdiction and am required to register in that state I shall be required to register in this State.

I understand that failure to comply with my responsibilities as defined here as well as my failure to comply with West Virginia Code § 15-13, et seq. are criminal violations of West Virginia Law, for which I may be criminally prosecuted.

I have read the Notification of Child Abuser Responsibility and Incarceration Release and I attest that the information I provided and submitted to DOC/ Jail Authority is true and correct.

I understand that is not a registration but a notice of my intent to reside at the address provided and a notice of my responsibilities. I understand I must register with the WVSP within 3 business days after my release in the county of residence.
