## New Leadership



West Virginia Governor Jim Justice has named **Loita Butcher** as acting commissioner of the WV Division of Corrections, the first woman to oversee the state's prison system.

Butcher is a veteran of the agency, having most recently served as assistant commissioner and prior to that as chief of staff. She first

joined the Division of Corrections in March 1994, and her career in law enforcement and public safety spans more than three decades.

*"Loita Butcher has been a valued leader within the Division of Corrections, and is dedicated to carrying out its vital mission,"* Cabinet Secretary Jeff Sandy said. *"She is committed to eliminating drugs and other contraband to ensure a secure and safe correctional system."*

Butcher succeeds Jim Rubenstein, who earlier announced his retirement effective April 1, 2017.

Jeff Sandy, Cabinet Secretary DMAPS announced that Deputy Commissioner **Mike Coleman** has agreed to be detailed from the Division of Corrections to the Office of the Secretary DMAPS, effective April 24, 2017. Mike began his corrections career as a Correctional Officer at the West Virginia Penitentiary in 1984 and his extensive experience amassed over three decades with the DOC and will be an asset to the Secretary's Office. He will be working with the Director of Correctional Operations, Joseph C. Thornton, on operational efficiencies, bringing the three state correctional agencies together and other corrections related issues.



Acting Commissioner Loita Butcher has appointed **Paul Simmons** (on left) as Acting Deputy Commissioner and **Scott Patterson** (pictured below) as Acting Assistant Commissioner effective May 27, 2017.



**John T. Murphy** was appointed Warden at the Huttonsville Correctional Center effective May 13, 2017.

**Marvin Plumley** has been selected to fill the position of Director of Compliance and Audits effective April 15, 2017. Marvin's office will be located at the same location as that of the CID Director and Auditor in Elkins.

**Russell Matheney** has been selected as the Acting Director of the WV Corrections Training Academy effective June 10, 2017.

Mr. Matheney began his employment with the WV Division of Corrections on November 1, 1994, at the WV Penitentiary (WVP) and then went to Mount Olive Correctional Complex upon the closing of the WVP. He worked as a Trainer at the Academy from 1999 to 2003 and then returned to Mount Olive as a Lieutenant. He was promoted to Captain in 2006 and eventually transferred to Salem Correctional Center in 2013. Mr. Matheney has also been a member, Team Leader and State Commander for Special Operations for approximately 21 years.

The children had not seen their mother, who was a parole offender, since the early hours of the day. The children were living in filth. The only food available for the children was crackers. The oldest child had a burn mark on his foot, caused by hot water that spilled while being carried to a bathtub. The bathroom had no running water.

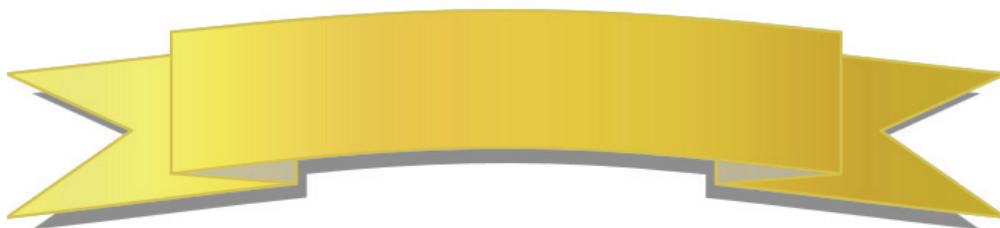
It was apparent that the children were relieved that the officers were there to help. The officers called the Sheriff's Office, which obtained the assistance of Child Protective Services. The officers used personal funds to feed the hungry children while waiting on Child Protective Services.

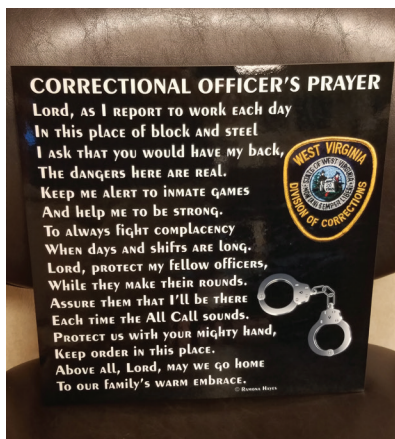

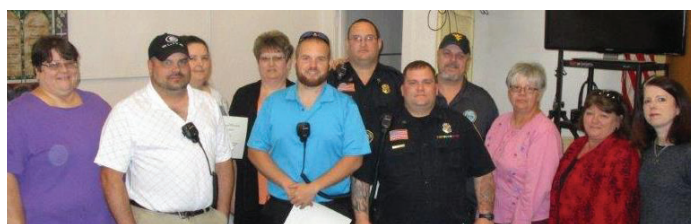

### 2017 MOCK Prison Riot: Moundsville, WV

The Mock Prison Riot (MPR) is a four-day comprehensive law enforcement and corrections tactical and technology tradeshow, including 44,000 square feet of exhibit space, training scenarios, technology demonstrations, certification and other workshops, a Skills Competition, and unlimited opportunities for feedback, networking, and camaraderie on a global scale. This year the MPR was held April 30 through May 3, 2017 in Moundsville, WV. There was a total attendance of 1066, with 28 states represented, 25 foreign countries and 55 exhibitors. SAVE THE DATE: Next year's MPR will be held April 29 through May 2, 2018.

For 2017 (and for the first time in 21 years!), the WV DOC and the West Virginia Corrections Training Foundation implemented a new scenario scheduling model. The new, more flexible model is intended to accomplish a few key goals going forward:

- First, teams that register at the last minute will still be able to participate, whereas before they would have been wait-listed or simply denied participation;
- Second, although the Mock Prison Riot has always been an international event, international participation has more than quadrupled in the past five years. This new model will give international teams more flexibility to prepare and execute training while on site;
- Third, this model will allow for the execution of more scenarios. Previously, only two scenarios per team were allotted;
- Fourth, this model should offer more realism. Often, team leaders, especially new teams were crafting scenarios for submission without ever having been on site; now teams can coordinate logistics and supplies with safety officers on site and in real time, resulting in a more productive and realistic training experience.

The days of date, time, and location being locked in for each team already are long gone. The new model allows for various areas of the compound to be opened up for blocks of time. Then, teams show up to whatever locations they prefer during the open times and execute their training.

Mock Prison Riot planners have been gathering feedback regarding the new model and are making adjustments accordingly for the 2018 event.
